# **SEPARATED**

During early March, the dominos of our world began to fall one after another. Announcements were made from national and state levels that the Coronavirus would spread throughout America and many lives would be lost. Health guidelines were given for our safety. Many things began changing that would separate our world.

We were told to socially distance ourselves from strangers, co-workers, friends, and family. Parents and grandparents could no longer hold or hug their children and grandchildren. It was okay to visit six feet apart. The sick went into the doctor's office or hospital while the family waited in the car until staff called with information. Those in nursing homes were shut off with outside contact only done through a window or by phone. Online or drive by birthday celebrations were the best we could do.

It is very difficult being kept apart from loved ones and friends. However, the worst separation is an eternal separation from our Maker, Savior, and Comforter. Jesus spoke of the religious of His day who neglected to help their brothers and sisters (Matt. 25:31-46). He specifically named things like the refusal to give food, drink, or clothing to those in need, and a failure to share a place to stay with those who had nowhere to go. Helping those is the essence of loving one another. The Son of God would finally say, "Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels" (Matt. 25:41).

Paul wrote about this ultimate divide. When the Lord returns, He will punish "those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Thess. 1:8). What will happen to those who oppressed His church and do not respond by believing in the Son of God and devoting themselves to Him? "These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord..." (2 Thess. 1:9). Separation forever!

You have opportunity now to come to Him and not be cut off because of your wrongs (Isa. 59:1-2). Even better, the Father will joyfully and lovingly welcome you. The central message in the story of the wayward son who returned to his father is how Jehovah responds to returning sinners (Luke 15:11-24). Jesus describes a dad running toward his boy when he was a far distance away. Once in His presence, he hugged the son tightly, gave him plentiful kisses, and threw a party celebrating the joy of no longer being separated from one another. Being with our Father, Savior, and the Spirit forever is the whole purpose of our salvation.
